

Jurij Dobravec, a biologist graduated at the University of Ljubljana in Slovenia, served as a researcher at the Triglav National Park headquarters for two decades, heading the Departments of Research and Informatics. During the developing of the concepts for the two national park information centres, his focus was on the techniques of effectively conveying scientific information to a wide range of visitors and target groups. Since 2010, Dobravec has worked as an independent researcher at the NGO Jarina Association, specialising in environmental ethics and spiritual aspects of nature preservation. In 2015, he participated an active role in the official Slovenian translation of Pope Francis's encyclical *Laudato si'*. His papers were presented internationally in conferences of the International Society for the Study of Religion, Nature, and Culture, ISSRNC. Lately, his study *Human-Nature Interrelationship in Wonder Tales of the European Tradition* has been accepted as a chapter in the *Handbook of Traditional Spirituality and Sustainability*, which will be published by Springer in 2024.
