I have experience in teaching approximately 250 hours every year in Bachelor and Master degree programs. I teach in three different teacher qualification programs: early childhood education teacher, primary school teacher, and subject education teacher programs. I am a teacher in charge for several courses yearly. I also supervise teacher training students at the university teacher training schools. Topics of teaching cover values education, societal and cultural aspects of diversity, social justice, pedagogy and didactics of religious and worldview education. I also teach research methodologies and educational research. Furthermore, I teach in Master seminar and PhD-seminars, and I have experience in organizing post-graduate courses for doctoral students.

I also have a lot of experience in planning, teaching and assessment in-service training at different educational levels. The most recent ones:
